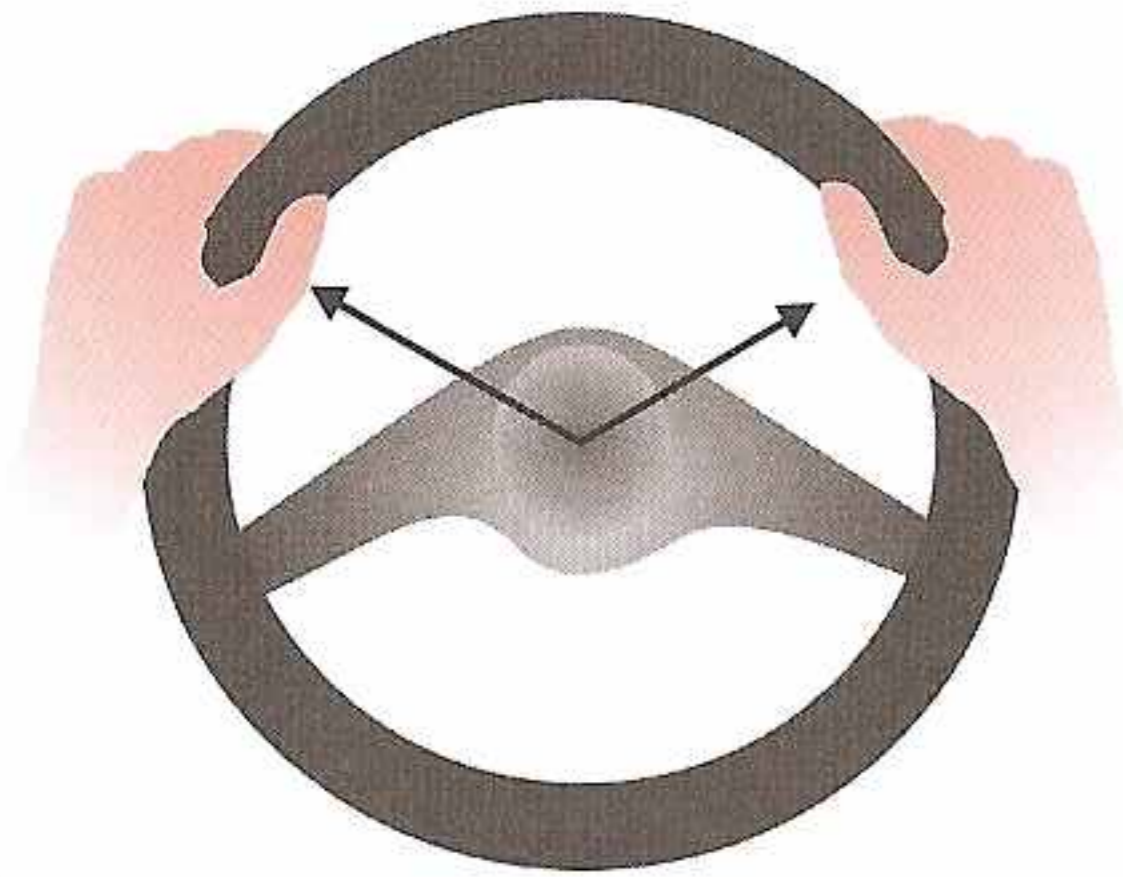
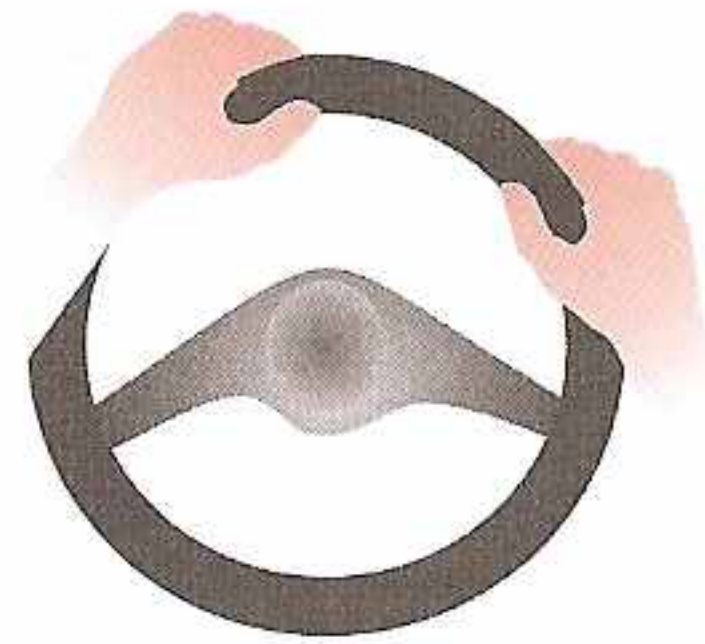

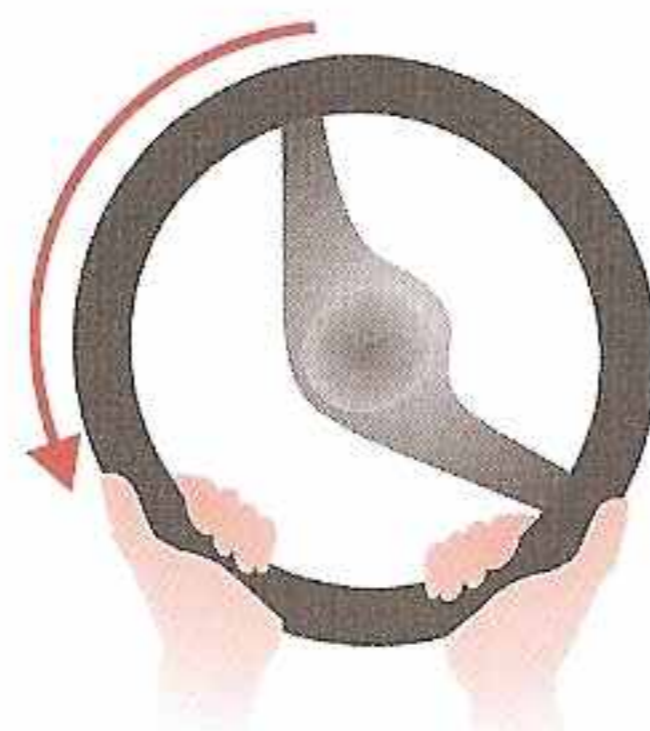


THE CORRECT HAND POSITIONS 10 TO 2

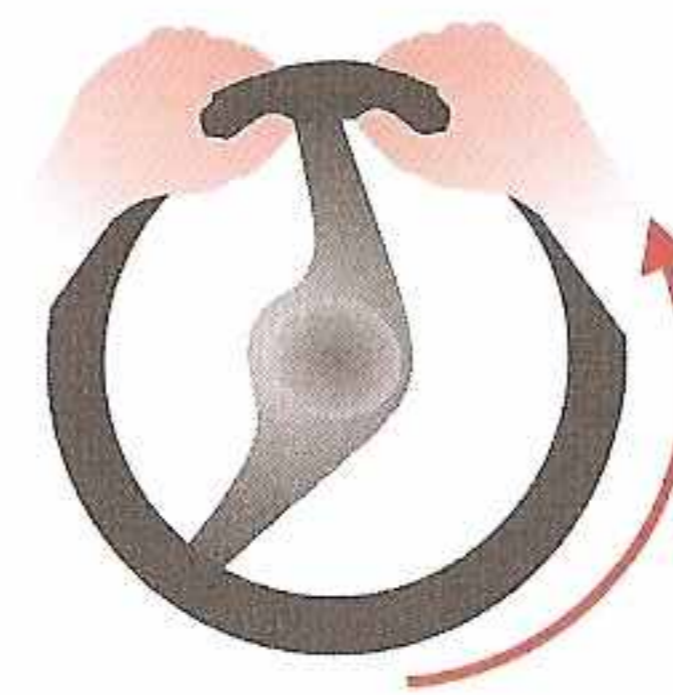
The Pull-Push Method TURNING LEFT



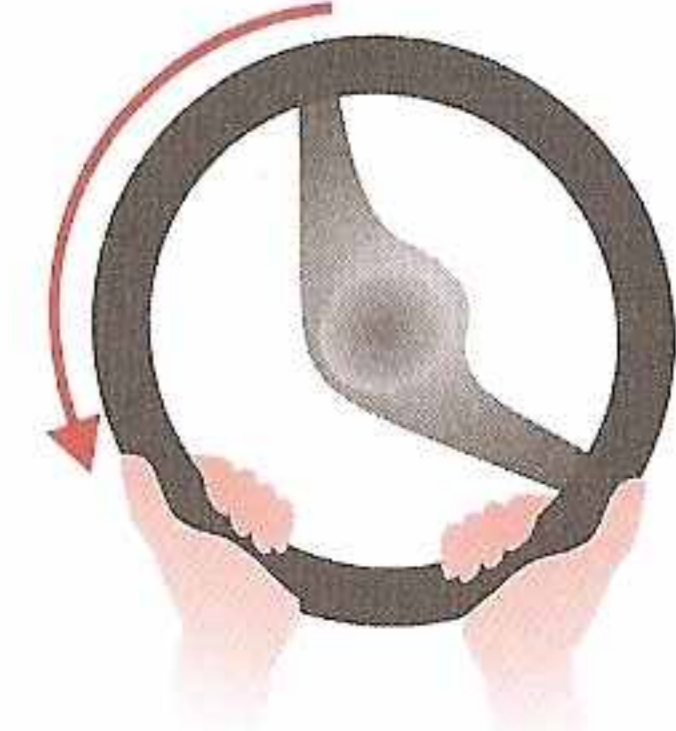
LEFT HAND SLIDES UP



LEFT HAND PULLS DOWN
RIGHT HAND SLIDES DOWN



LEFT HAND SLIDES UP
RIGHT HAND PUSHES UP



LEFT HAND PULLS DOWN
RIGHT HAND SLIDES DOWN

TURNING RIGHT USES THE SAME MOTIONS BUT WITH LEFT AND RIGHT HAND MOVEMENTS REVERSED.
